Upcoming Christmas Party

It's that time again, time for ETWC's annual Christmas Party. The party will once again take place at Sam Suffern's home, the party date is Saturday December 18, 2010 (Note: This date is a correction from the date contained in the November 2010 Newsletter). In keeping with tradition, there will be food, drink (alcoholic and non) and of course the traditional Chinese Gift Exchange. The club will provide both drinks and the main course (Ham and Turkey, prepared by Sam). Attendees should bring a side dish. In addition, if you desire to participate in the gift exchange bring a small wrapped gift (\$20-25), something you would enjoy receiving.

For those of you unfamiliar with the location of Sam's home, directions follow.

From Knoxville:

Take Rt 62 into Oak Ridge. At the Y-12 Federal Credit Union take a right onto Lafayette Avenue. Once on Lafayette Avenue go to the fourth traffic light, this should be the Oak Ridge Turnpike. Go right onto the Oak Ridge Turnpike. Travel past the Sonic and through the red light at Fairbanks Road. The Oak Ridge Veterinary Clinic will be on the right take the next left at the former Mattress Outlet Store (now closed). Travel a short block to a tee in the road. Turn right onto California Avenue, at the intersection with Delaware Avenue bare right; staying on California Avenue. Go to the top of the hill (approximately 1.1 miles). Take a right on East Drive, travel 300 yards and turn left onto Everest Circle. Sam's house is the second house on the left.

In case these directions don't work for you give Sam a call (483-4800), and he will talk you in. See you Saturday.

Winter Roll Practice

The winter roll practice schedule has been finalized. Practice will be at the Oak Ridge Civic Center from 8:30 to 10:00 pm on Friday nights. In past years, members provided "life guard" services. This year, Civic Center management is requiring the presence of a certified life guard which they will provide at additional cost. As a result, the cost to paddlers is going up. The fees are as follows:

Paddlers older than 18 years of age - \$5.00 / session, \$50.00 for the season. Paddlers 18 years old and younger - \$3.00 / session, \$30.00 for the season.

ETWC will still need to provide a paddler in charge (PIC) for each session. Since the Civic Center is providing life guard services, the duties of the host will be to setup the fee collection tripod and assure that all participants have completed the appropriate paperwork. Since there will be a life guard present, no training (First Aid/CPR) will be necessary for the PIC. If you would like to volunteer, contact Jason Darby (wepaddle@bellsouth.net).
